2016 ELL RENEWABLES RFP
Notice of Technical & Bidders Conference

The Louisiana Public Service Commission (“LPSC”) Staff has announced its intention to host a Technical Conference on the 2016 ELL Renewables RFP on May 12, 2016. Entergy Louisiana, LLC. (“ELL”) will host a Bidders Conference immediately following the Technical Conference for the 2016 Request for Proposals for Long-Term Renewable Generation Resources (“RFP”) on May 12, 2016.
